Remember: All the books have to be written or illustrated by Canadians. Check the bios at the back of the book or on the back cover to check if you're not sure.

Locate one book by Kenneth Oppel.		
Find any sequel to <i>Swindle</i> .		
Take a photo of the spine label for a Kelley Armstrong book.		
Find one Canadian book with the spine label of F SLA .		
Take a photo of a Jeremy Tankard picture book cover.		
Did you know <i>Franklin</i> is a Canadian book? Choose a favourite Franklin from when you were younger.		
Find a Canadian book with a spine label of E OHI .		
Find a non-fiction book that is all about Canada.		
Find a graphic novel written and illustrated by a Canadian with the initials S.C.		
Take a picture of the cover of <i>The Paperbag Princess</i> to show who wrote and illustrated it.		
Find another picture book with artwork by the illustrator of <i>The Paper Bag Princess</i> .		
Though written over one hundred years ago, this book still has tourists from all over the world visiting Prince Edward Island to see the fictional place called Green Gables. Take a photo of this famous book's cover.		
Kit Pearson is a famous Canadian author. Read the author's bio to tell me whether Kit Pearson identifies as a she or a he.		
Look for Marie-Louise Gay's picture books about a sister and brother. Take a photo of the front cover and the back cover of the same to discover a pattern. that shows up in all their books.

<i>This Is Not My Hat</i> is written and illustrated by a Canadian though the book has won many major American awards.		
Find an Indigenous picture book about residential schools.		
What fearful squirrel always makes an emergency plan that involves playing dead as a last resort?		
This author/illustrator using plasticene for her picture book art. Take a photo of any one of her books.		
One of Deborah Ellis's novels was recently made into a movie. Find out its name and take a photo of its cover.		
Kathy Stinson thinks <i>Red is Best</i> . What do you think?		
Jean Little lost her sight many years ago and has had a use a seeing eye dog to help her get around. Not surprising that she has written books with dogs as important characters. Find one.		
Find a book of historical fiction by Janet Lunn.		
Werner Zimmerman has illustrated several picture books based in Christmas. Take a photo of any one.		
This early reader graphic novel has a cat that thinks flies are aliens and outer space is outside the house. Ashley Spires wrote and illustrated this series.		
The <i>Screech Owls</i> are a hockey team. Who wrote this series about them? Note: he was a sports writer.		
The <i>7 series</i> has seven books in it. Take a photo of at least two books in the series.		
Margaret Atwood is best known for her award-winning adult books but she's also written for children. Find one of her children's books.		
Phoebe Gilman is Canadian. Take a photo of one of her tales.		
Frieda Wishinsky has written picture books, novels and non-fiction. Get a photo of 3 different genres of her books.		
Find a book about a Coyote legend.
