



FAQs for Educators:

*I reached out to a creator to book a session and they didn't answer. Can you help me contact them?*

Sorry, we are unable to facilitate communication between educators and creators. It's possible your request or their response got stuck in spam. You may want to try emailing from a different account; if you still don't receive a response, assume they are unavailable and move to a different creator on your list.

*Can I book more than one creator that day?*

You may book as many as you can fit in your schedule!

*I'm an educator in another country; can I still participate?*

Absolutely! We're all about celebrating Canadian books all around the globe. But you may want to investigate whether your students can access the creators' books before scheduling a reading, as some titles may be hard to find outside Canada. And keep time zones in mind when booking!

*My school can no longer participate in the reading I arranged. How do I cancel?*

Reach out to the creator directly and let them know. (The sooner the better so they can work on filling the spot.)

*November 4 isn't a good day for my school. Can we do it on a different day?*

These free readings are only available on I Read Canadian Day. But you can always talk to your chosen creators about scheduling a regular author visit on a day that works for both of you!
